Patterson Bro., 3,825 bronze metal, 25 cents each, unpolished, 26 cents each, polished.
Wilson Bohman, 3,825 bronze metal, \$3.75 per dozen; keys, 75 cents per dozen.
American Telephone Booth Company, 3,825 bronze metal, 44 cents each.

Whereupon, it was

Resolved, That the proposal of Hammacher, Schlamm & Co. to furnish the Police Department with 3,825 bronze metal padlocks, No. 1482, as per sample, all to pass sample key and to be delivered within two weeks after receipt of order, at the several station-houses, as per instructions to be given by the Chief of the Bureau of Elections, for the sum and price of \$1.45 per dozen, be and is hereby accepted. All aye.

In view of the fact that the Secretary of State has declined to authorize that ballots for Constitutional Amendments and propositions, to be submitted for the vote of the People at the ensuing election, shall be numbered.

Resolved, That the opinion of the Counsel of the Corporation be and is hereby respectfully requested as to whether the Board of Police should number such amendments or other propositions, under the provisions of section 6, chapter 680 of the Laws of 1892, and also to label and number one ballot-box at each polling place for the reception of ballots upon such amendments or propositions to correspond with such amendments or propositions respectively, under the provisions of section 13 of said Act.

Resolved, That the persons named in list marked "G," be selected and appointed as Inspectors of Election in the several Districts named, in the place and stead of those previously selected, approved and appointed, who have resigned, failed to qualify, etc. That said list be approved and ordered on file in the Bureau of Elections, and the Chief of the Bureau be directed to issue the necessary notices to said persons, and qualify them according to law.
