- For the construction of a portion of the Rondout-West Branch Tunnel of the Delaware Aqueduct, in the Towns of Wawarsing, Rochester and Gardiner, Ulster County, New York, all as set forth in the specifications. This portion of the tunnel will be about 75,100 feet in length, will have a finished diameter of 13½ feet within the concrete lining and its construction will be carried on through Shafts 2, 2A and 3, approximately 825 feet, 1,555 feet and 840 feet in depth, respectively, which have been excavated and lined with concrete under another contract, 150.
- For furnishing, testing and delivering bronze access doors, bronze gate, needle and check valves, bronze foot and flap valves, bronze piping, bronze elevator guides and miscellaneous bronze and steel castings for the Delaware Aqueduct, all as set forth in the specifications, 170.
